



Operation Helping Hands College Scholarship Program

Operation Helping Hands is a 501(c)3 dedicated to helping the homeless and housing insecure. Operation Helping Hands College Scholarship program offers a \$1000 per month stipend to be paid to the landlord of selected housing insecure students.

Operation Helping Hands works with local community colleges to identify students who have indicated housing insecurity on college financial aid applications. Once identified, those students are screened to identify students who meet the stipend criteria which include a cumulative GPA of 2.9 and enrollment in 9 units or more. Students meeting the requirements are then asked to complete a separate Operation Helping Hands questionnaire from which 5 students are selected to be interviewed by the Operation Helping Hands Board of Directors. After in person or Zoom interviews are completed, Operation Helping Hands selects at least one student per semester to receive a \$1000 per month stipend to be paid directly to the students' landlord. Operation Helping Hands will continue to pay that students stipend through graduation so long as the student continues to meet the minimum requirements.
